Activity # 3, Perspectives on Colonialism in the News Media

Module Name: A Consideration of Ethics in Chinua Achebe's novel *Things Fall Apart*

Class type: ESOL ESE Regular Gifted Honors Inclusion All

Objectives for activity:

- 1. Identify key moral dilemmas within the novel, and apply them to other "real life" situations
- 2. Describe core values and the extent to which they apply to characters and their actions in the novel
- 3. Better understand the universality of ethics

Materials Needed (texts, props, special supplies)

- 1. paper and pen or computer for completing writing assignment.
- 2. a computer for online research

Procedures for Teachers-What You Need to Know/Do

- 1. Review material on the news stories are reported (Reference Activity #3 in the main module for background.) and discuss how news coverage can reflect colonial power structures and traditions.
- 2. Have students go online to search for a particular historical event that reflects colonialism or choose a particular day for them to examine evidence of colonialism at work.

- 1. Classroom discussion.
- 2. Online research.
- 3. Completion of writing assignment.
