Read and review the four chapters from *Walden* used in this module. 2. Review the material on Virtue Ethics and Environmental Ethics found in the Background for Teachers included in the main module. 3. Discuss the definitions of Virtue Ethics and Environmental Ethics with students. 4. Expand the classroom discussion to include what the students consider to be a "good life" and decide what ethics are necessary to enable them to live that life. Activity Type -Discussion Questions, Compositions, Small Group, etc.-What Students Need to Do 1. Reading of selections from Walden. 2. Classroom discussion. Assessment 1. Student completion of four selections from Walden. 2. Evaluation of student participation in classroom discussion.
