Activity # 3 Class Debate: Capital Punishment Yes or No

Module Name: Capital Punishment

## Objectives for activity:

- 1. Understanding the fundamental ethical value of individuality
- 2. Understanding, identifying and distinguishing different arguments *for* and *against* capital punishment
- 3. Understanding and identifying the difference between *moral* and *legal* arguments for and against capital punishment
- 4. Understanding and identifying kinds of crimes
- 5. Understanding and identifying kinds of punishments

## Materials Needed (texts, props, special supplies)

1. computer or library for research to help prepare for classroom debate

### Procedures for Teachers-What You Need to Know/Do

- 1. Review background material under Activity #3 in the main text of this module.
- 2. Divide the class into two teams—one for and one against Capital Punishment.
- 3. Arrange time for student teams to research and prepare their positions for the debate.
- 4. Ask each team to choose their speakers.
- 5. Conduct the debate.

1. Classroom debate

- 1. Student participation, as a member of a team, in research for the debate.
- 2. Student participation in the classroom debate.
